Delta Retired Teachers' Association Scholarship Selection Guidelines (2024)

#### Qualifying candidates must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must be preparing for a career in Education (teaching or related field)
- 2. Graduate with a 'B' average in Grade 11 and 12 courses from a Delta secondary school with a minimum 'C+' in English 11 and 12.
- 4. Must have been enrolled full-time in Delta School District #37 for grades 10, 11 and 12.
- 5. Must have both volunteered and provided leadership within the community and their school in Grades 11 and 12.
- 6. Proof of attendance at a post-secondary institution will be required before the scholarship is presented.

## Areas that will be considered in selecting a well-rounded applicant:

- 1. Career path in Education
  - Shadowing or working in an Education-related setting.
  - Demonstrated ability or skill in this chosen career path
- 2. Leadership
  - The ability to plan strategically and follow through for events or projects
  - Be able to communicate and enlist a team to support you
  - Help others to develop skills and confidence
- 3. Volunteerism
  - Time and skills donated to enhance an organization or individual
- 4. Personal skill set development
  - Athletics, theatre, dance, writing, arts, cadets, music, or other
- 5. Completion of application
  - Quality of introduction letter explaining why you are a good candidate for this scholarship
  - Completion of all documents required for this application
